Under the collaboration, WM LampTracker, Inc., a subsidiary of Waste Management, will provide free recycling services for used ink and toner cartridges. Free recycling boxes are available by logging onto www.wmlamptracker.com and clicking on "Cartridge Recycling" under the Products drop-down menu. Approximately 350 million printer cartridges are discarded annually. Many can be remanufactured to perform as well as original cartridges, preserving valuable natural resources during the manufacturing process. Those cartridges that cannot be remanufactured are shredded and recycled.

Remanufactured cartridges typically cost 20-40% less than original equipment manufacturer's (OEM) cartridges. Through a co-branded site, Amazon.com/PrintClub, WM customers and employees are able to save hundreds if not thousands of dollars each year on their printing supplies.

"This is a win-win for customers that choose to take advantage of this program," said Matt Coz, vice president Product Recovery Group, Waste Management. "Not only can customers recycle their used ink and toner cartridges in an environmentally responsible way for free, they can also buy the replacement supplies for their business's needs at a substantial discount over new non-recycled cartridges. That is a GREEN story that every business, large and small, would love to take advantage of."
